dehydrated – adj. the state in which a large amount of water has been lost or removed from the body or from food. *Dehydrated fruit makes a great snack. When Janie had the stomach flu, she became dehydrated.*

hydrant – n. a pipe in or near the street that provides water, especially for putting out fires. *There are twelve fire hydrants on Main Street.*

hydrate – v. to add water or moisture to something; to supply something with water. *After being in the sun, it's important to hydrate your skin with lotions, gels, or creams.*

hydraulic – adj. operated by the pressure of a fluid. *An airplane is controlled using an extensive hydraulic system.*

hydroplane – v. to slide on a wet road because a thin layer of water on the road causes the tires to lose contact with it. *You must be careful when driving in rain so that your car does not hydroplane.*

Aquarium – n. a container of water for animals.

Aquatic – adj. having to do with water.

A shark is an aquatic animal because it lives in the ocean.

Aqueduct – a pipe or channel that leads to water to certain places.

The farmers built an aqueduct over the valley to move water to their fields.
