- The New Deal was Franklin D. Roosevelt's plan for the country.
- The New Deal centered around three goals:
 - Relief
 - Recovery
 - o Reform

Relief

• One program spent 500 million dollars to bring relief to the poorest of people.

Recovery

• CCC (Civilian Conservation Corps)

Set up work camps for men between 18-25 to provide work and a way to send money to their families.

TVA (Tennessee Valley Authority)

The TVA built dams along rivers in the south to prevent flooding and providing electricity to rural areas.

• WPA (Works Progress Administration)

The WPA employed people to build roads, schools, bridges, parks, and airports.

Reform

- Reform programs tried to prevent the problems that caused the Great Depression from happening again.
- SEC (Security and Exchange Commission)

The SEC was created to protect investors in the stock market.
